Qualifications Scotland Results Day and Appeals Process

Qualifications Scotland will release this year's results to candidates across Scotland on Tuesday 4 August 2026. Mrs Stewart, Depute and Qualifications Scotland Coordinator, will be available on 4th August, 10.00 am to 1.00 pm, to discuss results with pupils or parents, especially if these have an impact on higher education courses or school courses chosen for 2026/27. Please contact the school by telephone on 01854 612078 in the first instance.

The arrangements for appeals 2026 are the same as last year but it is important to be familiar with this process. Candidates and families/carers should note that alternative assessment evidence will not be looked at by the Qualifications Scotland. If a candidate or the school (with the consent of the pupils and Parent/Carer) does appeal, a senior marker will carry out a marking review of the Qualifications Scotland-marked assessments. This is not a full re-mark of a candidate's exam paper but a quality assurance check.

Priority Appeals (UCAS places depend on results etc):

Please note that the Appeals Learner Direct Service for priority appeals opens at 9am on 4th August and closes at 11.59pm on 11th August. This is where candidates appeal directly themselves without using school support. You will need your Scottish Candidate Number for this process.

Priority Appeals processed by schools close on 20th August at 5pm.

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Non-priority appeals:

Learner Direct non-priority appeals open at 9am on 4th August and close at 11.59pm on 25th August.

Non-priority appeals processed by schools open at 9am on 4th August and close at 5pm on 28th August.

If you wish to discuss a non-priority appeal, please contact Mrs Stewart on 01854 612078.

Please be aware that following an appeal or markers review, the final grade could stay the same, go up, or could go down.

We recommend that learners discuss any potential appeal with the school Qualifications Scotland coordinator in the first instance to determine whether an appeal is in their best interests. This conversation may include whether the certificated grade is in line with the school estimate, and whether that final grade is reflective of evidence gathered during the course. Not achieving an estimated grade would not be the only consideration. If you wish the school to appeal on your behalf, consent is required from the candidate and parent/carer. Please contact the school for a permission slip to request a marking review to be processed by the school.
