The Transition Process

- ▶ Information Sharing
 - Pastoral and curricular information gathered from primary colleagues
 - Helps to ensure appropriate support and progression
- ▶ Enhanced Transition
 - For young people who require additional support with the move to secondary
 - Additional activities/visits arranged by the Support for Learning department
- ▶ P7 visits by Guidance staff
 - Pupils learn more about the school/S1 and have the opportunity to ask questions
- ▶ Induction Days – Thursday 6th and Friday 7th June
 - Meet their teachers and classmates
 - Pupils are assigned buddies to show them around

Lockers

- ▶ Pupils allocated a locker for their personal possessions
- ▶ Health & safety - pupils keep possessions with them if they don't have a locker (not left lying around the school!)
- ▶ One-off £10 deposit (refundable on the return of the locker, padlock and key, undamaged)
- ▶ Letter (June)
- ▶ Lockers allocated on the first day – £10 required
