

## **DRESS CODE 2014-15**

### **Core Items (must be worn)**

A collared white or black or sky blue shirt, blouse or polo shirt.

Black trousers or skirt.

A plain black or navy blue or sky blue top such as a jumper or sweatshirt.

For formal occasions, such as when representing the school, a school tie must be worn with a collared shirt or blouse.

Black shoes are recommended but trainers are acceptable.

Gym Kit to be a white or black T-Shirt, polo shirt and shorts (no football team kit or colours).

Footwear for gym must be suitable for indoor use.

**Note: No T-shirts, or any top with writing or logos are allowed (except school logo when it becomes available).**

**No denim or jeans of any colour are allowed.**

### **Optional items**

The school tie may also be worn during the school day but it is not compulsory.

When pupils first enrol at Ullapool High School, they will be given a school tie, which can be collected from the school office.

However, extra ties are always available and can be ordered from the school office at any time.

### **Non Clothing Items**

Make up, jewellery and piercings must be appropriate for school. School management will assume responsibility for deciding what is acceptable.

### **Exceptions**

Any exceptions to the approved scheme will be agreed with the school management. Example: Dress down days may be allowed for specifically agreed events e.g. charity events.
